CASA is committed to ensuring as many members as possible have a chance to cross the stage in 2020. Due to the uncertainty of when we will be able to reopen the Royalty Theatre we have decided there will be NO Solo / Duo competition this year. We are allowing clubs to focus on the team competitions to engage their members.

Please find below CASA's plan for State Championships 2020. All age sections **must** compete in 1 apparatus item. For members to be eligible for 2021 National or Darwin Teams and to compete in 2021 Graceful Girl they must cross the floor in the minimum items set out below.

Competition format will be like Masters and non competitive Tinies with No Aggregate. Only 1st, 2nd, 3rd place will be awarded. Teams will decide how many items and which items they enter from the 2020 rotation

Dates to return to training are subject to Government restrictions being lifted. After SA Premier announcement 8/5/20 this could be as soon as 8/6/2020
